



## 360 REVOLUTION: Daily Prayer Guide

### SUNDAY

Join other believers to pray for your friends who need Christ. Whether at church, a small group, or while gathered with family or friends, pray for each of your friends by name. Agree together with these believers in prayer for life change.

### MONDAY

Pray through the scriptures (to reveal truth, to be encouraged, for strength, etc.) as you pray for those friends. Consider the following scriptures: Romans 10:1; 2 Peter 3:9; Matthew 9:37–38; 1 Timothy 2:1–6; 1 John 5:14; Acts 26:16–18

### TUESDAY

In addition to your three friends, pray for your church to be a lighthouse to your community. Earnestly seek the Lord as you lift up the congregation and its spiritual leaders. Pray for vision and mission to be realized, as God's work is carried out among his people. Pray that true revival would come, and that it would begin with you.

### WEDNESDAY

In addition to your three friends, pray for revival in your community, state, and country. Remember 1 Timothy 2:1–6 as you lift up local, state, and national leadership. Pray that hearts would turn to God and that his unending mercy and grace would be upon us. With utmost humility and boldness, plead with the Lord for the kind of transformation and healing imagined in 2 Chronicles 7:14.

## **THURSDAY**

In addition to your three friends, pray for God's work around the world. Thank the Lord for his desire that all nations turn to him. Thank him for ministries like Global Strategy and Children of Promise, which bring the hope of the gospel to the ends of the earth. Pray for our missionaries, national leaders, and churches on the ground all around the world. Consider the implications of Acts 1:8 as you pray.

## **FRIDAY**

Pray for boldness to reach out to your friends with the Good News of the gospel. 2 Corinthians 3:12 says, "Therefore, since we have such a hope, we are very bold" (NIV). You and your friends matter to God. You and your friends need Jesus. We can all agree on that, right? But God does not call us to simply agree; he calls us to act. Pray for an increased passion for the lost. Pray for opportunities to have spiritual conversations. Pray that you will recognize those opportunities and have the courage to seize them.

## **SATURDAY**

Fast one meal; make contact with one friend by e-mail, social media or phone, or in person. Work on the relationship, then look for opportunities to take the conversation in a spiritual direction. Remember, fasting is a biblical way to devote yourself to prayer and seeking God's will. Spiritual fasting is not a way to lose weight or twist God's arm. It's a way to hunger for God's will and be more mindful of prayer concerns. Each time your stomach growls with hunger, pray for God to move in the lives of your friends. Take the meal time you would usually spend eating and pray and journal to God. Then get up and do something courageous for God!
